We would like to thank you for your contributions to our initiatives this past year as well share some of the highlights of the great year we had.



Trauma Care

The M. Kukoyi Foundation (MKF), in partnership with Health Emergency Initiative (HEI), assisted 39 critically injured Road Traffic Accident (RTA) victims in Lagos through provision of funds for the first 24 hours of trauma care. We recorded an 82 percent survival rate in avoidable deaths from road crashes.



World AIDS DAY 2022

In partnership with The Mercy Michael Foundation, we provided comprehensive services including blood pressure checks, glucose checks, HIV testing & counseling, and contraceptive distribution. Of the 123 individuals who received testing (comprising 70 males and 53 females), two individuals were newly diagnosed with HIV. They were promptly referred and accompanied to healthcare facilities to begin their journey of receiving appropriate care. The remaining individuals who were retested were encouraged to continue their current medication regimen.

Feed the Elderly and Widows Campaign

In partnership with the Mercy Michael Foundation, we continued our distribution of food items to 40 widows. We also provided preventive medical services such as glucose level checks and blood pressure checks to 120 elderly members of the Kuchikau community.
