# Program Highlights – July to Dec 2025

# C.A.R.E Project (CPR & Accident Resuscitation Education)

**Ongoing Since: April 2023**

**Goal:** To increase bystander readiness in emergencies by teaching CPR, bleeding control, burn care, and basic first aid.

Our C.A.R.E Project continued stronger than ever, bringing hands-on CPR, bleeding control, burn care, and emergency response skills to students and community members across Lagos.

Recent trainings included:

- **ALX Africa (July)** – 44 participants
- **The Muslim Student Society of Nigeria – University of Lagos Chapter (July)** – 39 participants
- **National Health Students Society (Sept)** – 58 participants
- **Lagos State Scout Council (Oct 18)** – 27 participants

This bring the total to 168 participants trained in the last half of 2025.

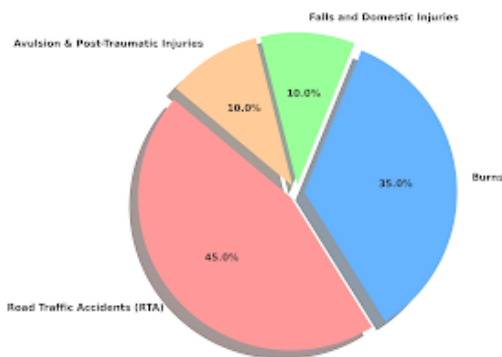
**TOTAL IMPACT FOR 2025:**

**325 people trained** in CPR and First Aid this year alone – a powerful testament to the reach of community training.





Our volunteer trainers, supervised by licensed medical professionals, continue to lead impactful, hands-on workshops with the support of our Basic Life Support (BLS) equipment, manikins, and training kits.




## Trauma Intervention Program

From July to December 2025, we supported **27 trauma patients** across partner hospitals. Cases included:

- Severe burns
- Fractures and dislocations
- Road traffic accident injuries
- Deep lacerations, avulsions, and heavy bleeding
- Emergency surgical interventions

Each intervention was funded to ensure timely care within the critical first 24 hours—often the difference between life and death.

### TOTAL TRAUMA SUPPORT IN 2025:

 76 trauma patients supported across the year.

## Partnerships & Community Projects

# Princess Adetutu Ogunsanwo (PAO) Foundation

This December, MKF partnered with PAO Foundation to bring joy, dignity, and relief to students and teachers at:

## U.A.M.C (Eleja) Primary School, Igbogbo

### Completed Impact:

- **100 schoolbags** donated
- Each bag included school supplies: notebooks, pens, pencils, sharpeners, erasers, rulers, and water bottles
- **Foodstuff packages for 30 teachers**, honoring their dedication and supporting their households during the December season
- Each Package included: a mini bag of rice & garri, a bottle of groundnut oil, and spices.

This collaboration strengthened our education support mandate and planted seeds of hope for a brighter academic year ahead.



# Mercy Michael Foundation

## 1. School Infrastructure Support

MKF donated **30 classroom furniture units** (seating over 60 students) to:

*L.G.E.A Pilot Science Primary School, Mararaba Gurku, Karu LGA, Nasarawa State*

These desks and benches give children a cleaner, safer, and more dignified environment for learning.

## 2. Feed & Clothe the Elderly Outreach

A December outreach supporting **150 elderly individuals** with:

- Foodstuff
- Clothing
- Emotional support
- Preventive Health Screenings

## 3. Sexual & Reproductive Health Outreach

Also completed in December, serving **150 community members** with:

- Health talks
- HIV, Hepatitis B & C screening
- BP & glucose checks
- Free vaccinations
- Condom distribution
- Referral and linkage to care

This project strengthened our joint commitment to prevention, early detection, and community health literacy.

- **Annual Webinar:** We hosted an educational webinar this year (thank you to all who attended and shared).



- **Gala 4:** Our 4th Annual Gala took place (virtual). Thank you to every donor, sponsor, and guest who helped make it possible.
